We'll it was a fantastic run of great January weather. However, at the time of this writing snow is in the air. Our record pace for playable days to golf is now in jeopardy. Through the end of January, we've only been closed 16 days. The previous best season was the winter of 2021/2022 where we were closed for a total of only 24 days. Prior to that, we must go all the way back to 2012/2013 to find another winter with less than 30 days closed. But now it looks like February will be a cold month, guess we can't get too excited because Mother Nature can still throw us curve ball. 7 years ago, in February (2018/2019) we had a huge snowfall that kept us closed for 52 days over February and March.

Regardless of what the weather does this spring; we are on track for another great season of golf here at Eagle Crest. Our foundation here is the best it's been in 20 years. We continue to make incremental improvements across our departments which are confirmed by all the positive feedback we receive.

Our Planned 2025 projects include Resort Course golf shop upgrades for patio, restrooms and F&B, Resort irrigation upgrades & filling in pond between holes #6 & #8. refurbishing the Ridge pavilion, Ridge shop new carpet, Ridge cart paths, installing new drainage, new Ridge hole #18 fountain,

On The Green

Sunshine is staying around a bit longer and the shadows are slowly starting to change but winter is still here, and I would imagine packing at least a couple more solid punches to remind all of us that spring is still waiting.

The slow start to winter and lack of freezing in January allowed golf maintenance staff to get a head start on some projects and renovations. Drainage systems have a life span of about 25-30 years in cool climates and we have started to see failures on all three courses that extend beyond our ability to flush the perforated pipes and reestablish the needed drainage. Our plan is to replace and extend in areas where needed approximately 3,000 lineal feet of drain lines this off season between the three courses.

Our maintenance staff have begun addressing the crowning in tee boxes especially on the Challenge course but there will be additional work done on selected tee boxes for the Ridge and Resort course where we have identified the worst areas. Tee boxes generally have a life span of 15-20 years when sized correctly to handle higher volumes of usage and the courses are showing their age regarding the infrastructure and construction.

We are again utilizing the winter months to do our part regarding the Community Wildfire Protection. Grants that have greatly reduced the risk of a catastrophic fire have and will continue to be utilized. We continue to work with the CWP Committee to facilitate the removal and disposal of fire fuels. This has been a very beneficial partnership for the last 8 years and will continue for the foreseeable future.

Look for some changes on the Resort Course facilities this spring with new patio, additional restrooms, F&B upgrades. I know we're all ready for the sun to produce some much-needed heat and to pull us all from the doldrums of cabin fever with the lure of green grass, daffodils and our green golf courses.

2025 Annual Pass tidbets

Annual Pass information has now been released to our website at www.eaglecrestgolforegon.com Everyone is encouraged to view the information on the "golf passes" tab. There you can print the registration form that you 'll sign and return to the golf shop. This update pertains to the 2025 Annual Pass that begins March 1st and runs through February 28th of 2026. Below we've highlighted the two main changes being incorporated for 2025:

- 1. Range balls will again be included for annual pass holders. However, only the Platinum pass will continue to receive a full bucket each day. All other pass levels will have a half bucket included with their pass only on days their pass is valid. Gold pass holders which do not have playing privileges on Friday and Saturday would need to purchase their range balls on those days. Additionally, All Annual Pass holders will have the ability to purchase our range pass at half price in 2025.
- 2. In 2025 we will be offering a new introductory pass. The Quartz pass is for people interested in saving some money and that typically like to play their golf in the later afternoons. This will be available to new annual pass holders only. Anyone who is a first-time annual pass holder may purchase this pass and try us out. Similar to the Silver pass except play benefits begin after 2pm and reservations can only be made 7 days in advance. Winter play will be permitted on the Challenge Course only.

As we look towards the upcoming 2025 season, we want to take a moment and go over a few housekeeping items.

Last year booking tee-times online became popular and the standard procedure for booking tee times. We thank you for helping us create this standard. With this reliance and convenience, we have some instructions / reminders we need to share with everyone.

Cancelation of tee times! Times <u>must</u> be cancelled within the proper time frame, or the person booking the time will be responsible for no show fees. Just as you booked the time online you can go back in and cancel out as well. Calling the golf shop is an option but you'll have a record of the cancellation if you do it online. So, if you're booking for a group of guys or gals make sure everyone knows the importance of communication, are they playing or not playing? We will be closely monitoring this throughout the season and appreciate your consideration to this. Please know that we understand the occasional need to cancel due to sickness, or weather and we'll take that into account. But the people who simply do not manage their tee times well will be in for an awakening.

On days there may be a frost delay or closure we will have the Eaglecrestgolforegon.com website updated prior to opening shop. We will also email each those on the tee sheet letting you all know of potential delays more than 30 minutes. Please use these 2 tools to check prior to calling the shop. The web will be updated after a decision is made by our golf maintenance staff.
